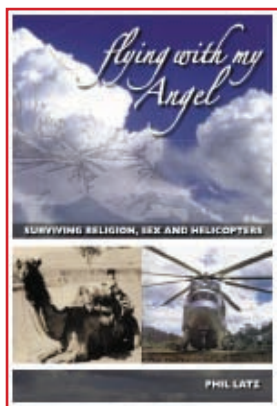


Biography



Faraway Days Author: *Sergei Rudolfovich Mintslov*

Sergei Rudolfovich Mintslov was one of Russia's most prolific authors. Born and educated in Tsarist Russia, he left his homeland after the Bolshevik revolution of 1917 and spent the rest of his life in exile in Riga, Latvia. *Faraway Days*, penned by Mintslov in 1918, is an autobiography recounting a mischievous childhood and early adulthood. This insight into life on the country estates of the nobility as well as the evolution of a young officer in the military academy in Nizhniy Novgorod and then Moscow is unlike any story previously told.



Flying with my Angel Author: *Phil Latz*

This memoir is a tale of life lived on the edge, from Phil's birth in a Hostel in Alice Springs, in 1937, to a traditional Society wedding in crusty Cheltenham, England. The mountain, The Forest and The Infinite Blue Sea Author: Eitan Daniel

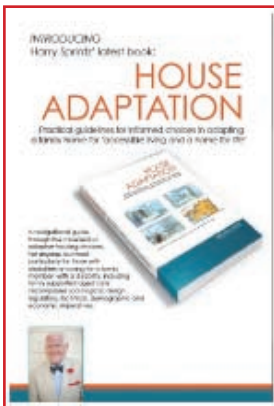
This collection of short stories depicts a series of experiences that were seminal moments within the author's personal development.

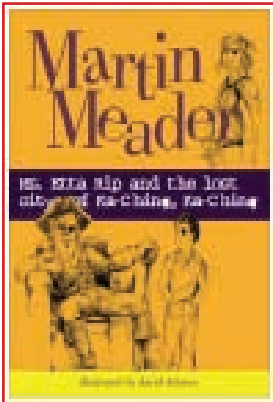
House Adaptation Author: *Harry Sprintz*

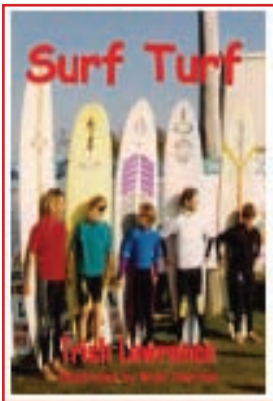

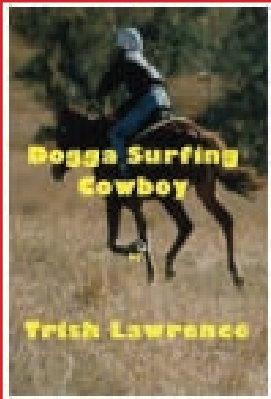
Dogga Hangs In:

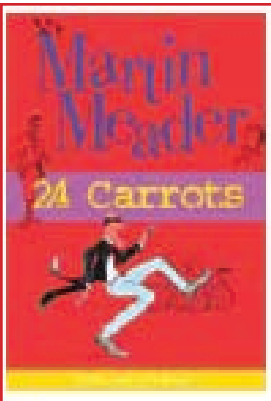

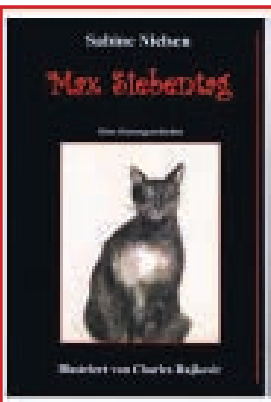
Dogga Surfing Cowboy:

Casa d' Amore is a junior novel, which should attract middle readers (9-12 years). At 22,700 words it is well paced and very accessible.

Partly written in diary form, it tells of Georgia who has to move with her mother to live with her grandmother. Near the house 'Casa d' Amore' she is pleased to find a playmate, but Ellie turns out to be obsessed with getting back something hidden in the yard of the next door neighbor, the crabby Mr. Bratten. Gradually it becomes obvious that Ellie is not what she seems. In fact she is the ghost of Georgia's unknown aunt, and this solves several mysteries that surround the old house and the grandmother herself.

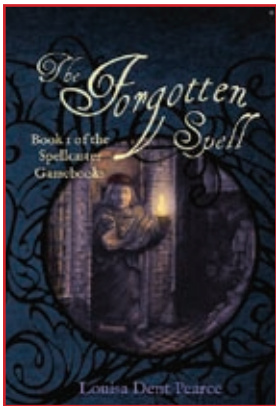
I have endeavored to have subtle clues leading the reader to wonder about Ellie and then be satisfied that she is a ghost. The theory of afterlife is no way offensive, but rather comforting. This story also addresses the issues of relationships between mother and daughter, (at two levels) and the effect of parental separation and the difficulties of letting go.

I have included a cat Turbo as one of the fun characters who adds a light touch to this children's fictional drama.

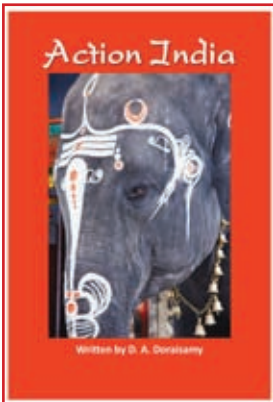
The Forgotten Spell Author: Luisa Dent Pearce

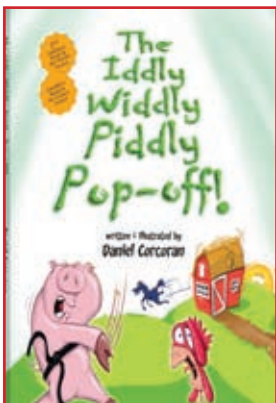
Mary The Hairy Fairy Author Daniel Corcoran

This Amazing tale traces the hilarious journey of a small deposit' through the household where some unsuspecting kids battle to find a way to deal with the unwelcome visitor.



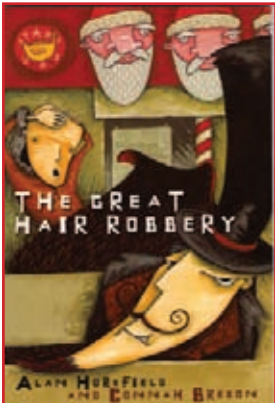

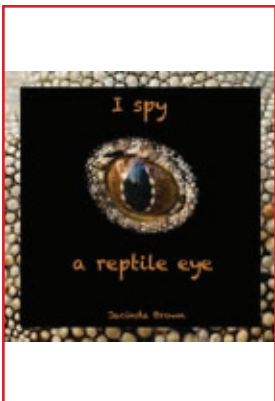

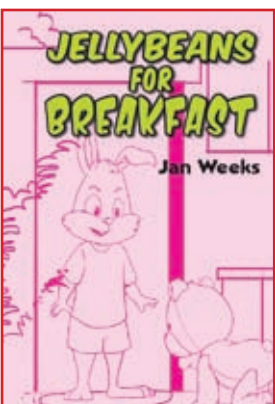
Synopsis

One thing about the reptile, Something we all share, Even those that live in water, Survive by breathing air.



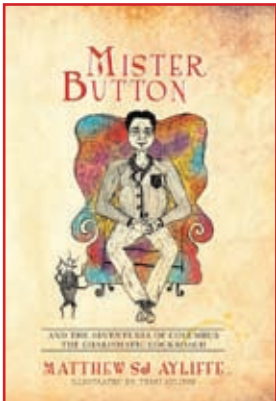

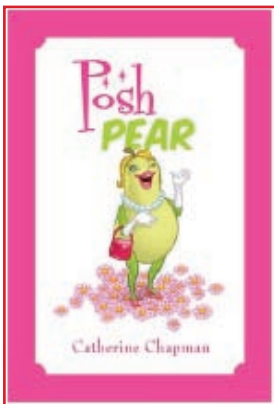
To The Beat Of My Own Drum,

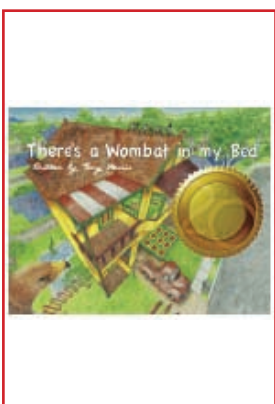
Kanga Author: *Ljubo Oblikov*, illustrated by *Rhonda Stewart*

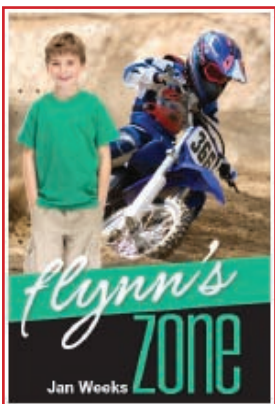
Book 2 - "Wild Woolly Wombat Sports" Author: Tony Harris

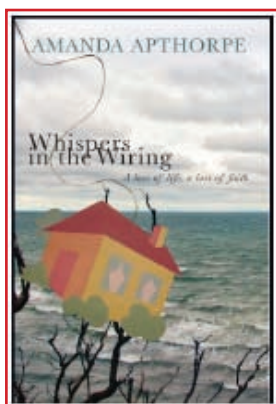
Sydney's song

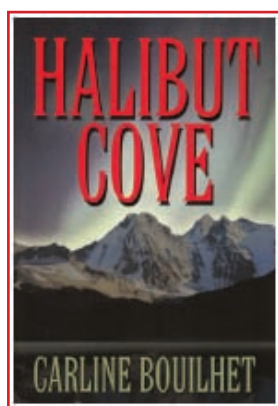
Whispers in the Wiring Author: Amanda Apthorpe
